
## **Advent and Christmas Activity sheets and ideas**



# 1. A Folded Christmas Tree from Colourthemoon.com

## You will need:



- Green cardstock
- Stick
- Ribbon
- Glitter
- Small bell
- Hole punch
- Hot glue gun



Start by cutting a triangle from the green card:



Fold the card shape accordion style, making each fold about 2.5 cm wide



Use a hole punch to make a hole in the centre of each fold



Thread a straight stick through the holes, decorate your tree with a bell or star on the top, and baubles, tinsel – whatever you want!

## 2. Stained Glass Star

## **INGREDIENTS**

- Printed template
- Tissue paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Twine
- Black card
- Self-adhesive paper (for covering books, etc)

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Download the star template (star template.pdf), print, and cut out (don't forget to cut out the centre).
- Trace the star template onto black card. Cut out.
- Cut a piece of contact paper a little larger than the star. Place star down on the sticky part of the self-adhesive paper, traced lines facing up.
- Cut small squares from tissue paper.
- Cover empty area with tissue paper, paying close attention not to go over the black border.
- Cut a second piece of self-adhesive paper a little larger than the star and cover the tissue paper. Press out any air bubbles.
- Cut the star out from the self-adhesive paper.
- Glue a piece of string to the back of the star for hanging on the Christmas tree or at the window.
- Your ornament is finished! The kids will have a blast making these.

draw a picture for each one;

find a carol that matches each one;

make them into an Advent Calendar behind doors.
