Prayer – is vital at all times, and certainly part of this Lent Course. We need to be praying now that we will all hear clearly what God wants to tell us, that we will understand and have courage to put it into practice, and that we will all grow as Christians. 3 ways you can do this: join an **informal prayer time** before each Sunday service in the lower hall, starting 9.30am, Sunday 26th February – add a **Prayer request/answer/bible verse** to the blue board in church – join in the **half day of prayer** for God to grow us: Sunday February 19th, 2pm to 4pm.

Also on prayer: there are some copies of the material for the **World Day of Prayer**, Friday March 3rd. Please take one from the table at the back of the church to use; if you need more, please see Jan.

Living Lightly 24:1 – Some ideas for supporting nature in 2023: 1. Tell the government you demand lasting and meaningful change through legislation https://www.zerohour.uk/u4n/ 2. Be a conscious shopper: it's Fairtrade fortnight from February 27th to March 12th. Look for the logo as you shop for groceries in particular. 3. Be mindful of your money – many banks invest in damaging industries (fossil fuels, arms trade etc). Look at Triodos Bank for a different prospect. 4. Take a walk on the wild side: visit a Wildshire Wildlife reserve as the weather becomes a bit milder. There's still a lot to see!

The main source for this was Traidcraft plc (you may also have seen their catalogues in the café from time to time). Unfortunately they have gone into administration, after 40 years of trading, which is very sad news. There may be a possibility of rebranding, but for the foreseeable future Jan will be buying Fairtrade goods for use in church from other companies.
